England has had 63 monarchs.

Queen Elizabeth 11 and **Queen Victoria** are the two longest reigning monarchs in British history.
Charles III became king in 2022.

Elizabeth 1 was a Tudor queen from 1558 - 1603.

Comparing the lives of monarchs:-

Queen Victoria was married and had 9 children.

Queen Elizabeth 1 never married and had no children.

Queen Victoria's son Edward became king. She was the great great grandmother of QE11.

The death of Queen Elizabeth 1 was the end of the Tudor reign.

The royal family tree shows how members of the Royal family are related to each other.

King Charles III is the son of the late Queen Elizabeth 11. He has 2 sons - Prince William, the next heir to the throne and Prince Harry. He has 3 siblings - Prince Anne, Prince Andrew and Prince Edward.

He is married to Camilla who is the new Queen. King Charles III has 5 grandchildren.
