We welcomed Alice Wheatley back to Wentworth on 9th January following her expedition to Tanzania as part of Operation Raleigh. The children were captivated as she described the differences between children's lives in Tanzania and the UK. Children in Alice's village only attended school every other day as there were insufficient places for them all. The classrooms were bare, with no electricity or running water. Medical attention required a three hour drive and the sanitary conditions consisted of a hole in the ground for the toilet and a bucket of water for a shower. Children collected any rags or bits of plastic they could find to weave into a football shape to have a kick around. Our children are certainly very privileged.

Girls' Football

The girls had a resounding 8 - 0 league victory against Bean Primary School on the 21st January. The girls have moulded into a really strong team and can look forward to further successes.
